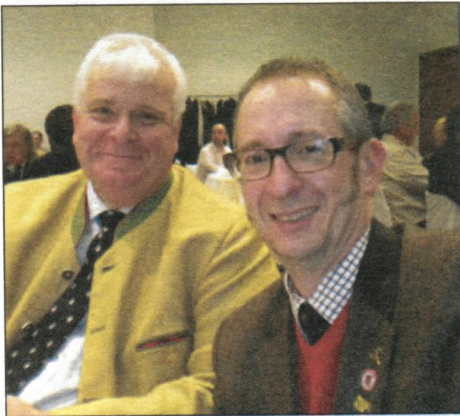


Cinegetica Hunting Show And Iberian Peninsula Chapters Fundraiser A Hit

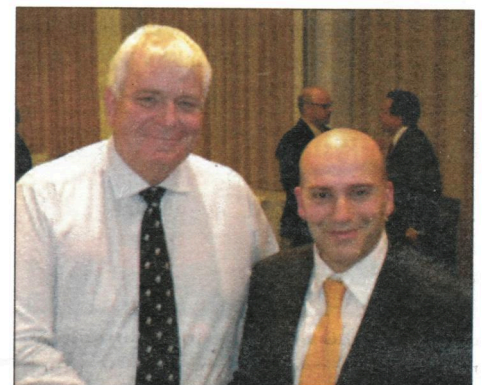
